

PURA VIDA DIVERS: 2020 ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

Applicant/Student (hereinafter referred to as "Student") has had the course(s) fully and completely explained to him/her and agrees to abide by the terms listed in this Enrollment Agreement and by the rules and regulations of Pura Vida Divers (hereinafter referred to as "School"). This agreement consists of two pages in conjunction with the catalog and constitutes the entire agreement between the School and the Student. The Student understands that if the School accepts this agreement, it shall be a binding contract and no further modification or representation except as herein expressed by both parties will be recognized.

METHODS OF PAYMENT: Acceptable forms of payment include: travelers checks, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover, money orders or cash. *Personal checks will be accepted for course deposits only if received a minimum of two weeks before the class start date.* The DEPOSIT is due at the time of signing the Enrollment Agreement and the BALANCE OF TUITION is required prior to attending the first class. All funds are payable in U.S. dollars.

Whenever possible, it is advised that the Enrollment Agreement be submitted with copies of certification cards, front and back, and a copy of the diving Medical Statement, signed by a doctor, stating Student is medically cleared to participate in diving activities and current within one year of start date of classes. These documents must be on file with the School before the start of Student's classes.

EMPLOYMENT: Although placement assistance can be offered if requested by the Student, the School does not guarantee employment.

CREDENTIAL AWARDED & GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION: A diploma is awarded to the Student who has successfully completed the program of study and fulfilled all monetary obligations to the School. The School reserves the right to terminate the Student or withhold the certificate for unsatisfactory attendance, unsatisfactory progress, and/or failure to comply with School rules or for nonpayment of monetary obligations to the School.

PADI FEES: *If Student is required to complete the Assistant Instructor course during Level II, the AI fee is not included. Also not included in course costs are any e-learning courses, required or elective.*

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY: Should a Student/applicant cancel his/her enrollment or be terminated by the School for any reason, all refunds will be made according to the following schedule:

1. Cancellation can be made in person, by electronic mail, by Certified Mail or by termination.
2. All monies will be refunded if the School does not accept the applicant or if the Student cancels within three (3) business days after signing the enrollment agreement and making initial payment. An applicant not requesting cancellation by the scheduled starting date will be considered a Student.
3. Cancellation after the third (3rd) business day, but before the first class, will result in a refund of all monies paid, with the exception of the deposit (but the amount withheld will not exceed \$150.00) and any eLearning fees if applicable. The cost of any books purchased from Pura Vida Divers that the student may wish to return will be refunded provided they are unopened and can be resold as new. The books must be returned within three (3) days of signing the Enrollment Agreement in order to receive a full refund. FAST TRACK Students Only: please be aware that once you are issued the equipment included with this program it cannot be returned. If you leave the program for any reason you will be financially responsible for the issued equipment at the cost of \$7,000.00.

4. Students voluntarily terminating and/or those dismissed by the School will receive a refund pro-rated on an hourly basis based on the number of hours completed to the total program hours. However, there will be no refunds issued once more than 40% of the program is completed.
5. Termination Date: When calculating the refund due to the Student, the last date of actual attendance by the Student is used unless earlier written notice was received.
6. Refunds will be made within 30 days of termination of the Student's enrollment or receipt of a Cancellation Notice from the Student.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS: I understand that in order to graduate from the program and to receive a diploma, I must successfully complete the required number of schedule clock hours as specified in the catalog and on the Student Enrollment Agreement, pass all written and practical examination with a 75% average and satisfy all financial obligations to the School.
